

Bindaree Food Group + Colin Say & Co Feedlot Trial and Carcass Competition

Terms & Conditions

- Entries submitted by 5pm Friday the 29th of May 2026.
- Entry Free -\$400/pen payable upon entry
- Bindaree will purchase the feeder cattle liveweight and will determine the grid price prior to delivery, Colin Say and Co will be facilitating and processing the sale.
- The liveweight grid specifications will show 380-500kg with deductions incurred if the weigh varies from this
- Number of pens per Exhibitor – max 3 pens per category
- There will be four class categories:
 - o Angus x Angus Steers
 - o Angus x Angus Heifers
 - o Crossbred Steers
 - o Crossbred Heifers
- Each entry consists of a pen that is made up of five head
- Both steers and heifers are eligible, however all five head in the pen MUST be the same sex.
- All cattle are to be pretreated with Bovilis MH+IBR between 2-6 weeks from feedlot entry where feasible. Please contact either Bindaree or Colin Say and Co Representative to establish a collection point for Bovilis MH + IBR.
- Cattle must have been owned for more than 2 months.
- Milk teeth only
- No HGP
- Exhibitors to arrange transport to the saleyards or alternatively contact Bindaree or CSC for assistance in transport.

- Competition Starts 8th July 2026
- The feedlot competition will take place at Bindaree Food Groups Myola Feedlot.
- Welcome BBQ Breakfast & Hoof Judging will take place at Inverell Saleyards at 7:30am – Wednesday the 8th of July 2026.
- Vendors selection for BEEF27 will take place on Thursday the 15th of October at the Myola Open Day.

- Final weigh day for all trial cattle 10th November 2026
- Processing date – Friday the 13th of November 2026
- Carcass Information session and chiller walkthrough – Sunday the 15th of November.
- Results announced at the presentation evening – Friday 27th November
